New Description – US 6 and its extensions in Muscatine County described as follows:

Beginning on the Muscatine–Johnson County line at a point approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile south of the NW Corner Section 6–T78N–R4W, Muscatine County (NE Corner Section 1–T78N–R5W, Johnson County); then in a southeasterly, easterly and southeasterly direction through Sections 6, 5, and 4–T78N–R4W to a point approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile east of the SW Corner of Section 4–T78N–R4W; then east following substantially the section line of Sections 9, 10, and 11–T78N–R4W; then easterly and southeasterly through Section 12–T78N–R4W to the west corporation line of West Liberty, connecting with an unnamed street.

West Liberty:

Beginning on an unnamed street at the west corporation line; then easterly on said unnamed street to Columbus Street; then southerly on Columbus Street to 3rd Street; then east on 3rd Street to the east corporation line.

Beginning again on the east corporation line of West Liberty, connecting with 3rd Street; then in an easterly and southeasterly direction through Sections 12–T78N–R4W and 7–T78N–R3W to a point approximately 1,000 feet east of the SW Corner Section 7–T78N–R3W; then in an easterly direction following substantially the section line of Sections 18, 17, 16, and 15–T78N–R3W to a point approximately 700 feet east of the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section 15–T78N–R3W; then in a northeasterly and southeasterly direction through the south part of Section 10–T78N–R3W and in a southeasterly and northeasterly direction through the north part of Sections 15 and 14–T78N–R3W to a point approximately 700 feet east of the NW Corner Section 14–T78N–R3W, then east following substantially the section line of Sections 14 and 13–T78N–R3W and

18, 17, 16, 15, and 14–T78N–R2W (south junction Iowa 38); then in a northerly direction following substantially the section line of Sections 12 and 1–T78N–R2W to the south corporation line of Wilton, connecting with an unnamed street.

Wilton:

Beginning on an unnamed street at the south corporation line; then northerly on said unnamed street to the north corporation line (Muscatine–Cedar County line).

DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND:

Due to its relocation, US 6 in Muscatine County should be deleted from the primary road system and the new description added should be officially included in the primary road system.

US 6 begins at the Muscatine-Johnson County line approximately five miles west of the City of West Liberty and proceeds easterly and northerly via the cities of West Liberty and Wilton to the Muscatine-Cedar County line in the City of Wilton.

PROPOSAL/ACTION RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended the commission approve deleting the present description of US 6 in Muscatine County from the primary road system and approve including the attached new description of US 6 in the primary road system.

Locate US 6 and its extensions in Muscatine County as follows:

Beginning on the Muscatine-Johnson County line at a point approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile south of the NW Corner Section 6-T78N-R4W, Muscatine County (NE Corner Section 1-T78N-R5W, Johnson County); thence in a southeasterly, easterly, and southeasterly direction through Sections 6, 5, and 4-T78N-R4W to

a point approximately ¼ mile east of the SW Corner of Section 4-T78N-R4W; thence east following substantially the section line of Sections 9, 10, and 11-T78N-R4W; thence easterly and southeasterly through Section 12-T78N-R4W to the north corporation line of the City of West Liberty, connecting with an unnamed street.

West Liberty:

Beginning on the north corporation line, connecting with an unnamed street; thence southerly and easterly to the east corporation line, connecting with an unnamed street.

Beginning again on the east corporation line of the City of West Liberty, connecting with an unnamed street; thence in an easterly and southeasterly direction through Sections 12-T78N-R4W and 7-T78N-R3W to a point approximately 1000 feet east of the SW Corner Section 7-T78N-R3W; thence in an easterly direction following substantially the section line of Sections 18, 17, 16, and 15-T78N-R3W to a point approximately 700 feet east of the N ¼ Corner Section 15-T78N-R3W; thence in a northeasterly and southeasterly direction through the south part of Section 10-T78N-R3W, crossing the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific Railway overpass at a point approximately 500 feet west of the NE Corner Section 15-T78N-R3W, and in a southeasterly and northeasterly direction through the north part of Sections 15 and 14-T78N-R3W to a point approximately 700 feet east of the NW Corner Section 14-T78N-R3W; thence east following substantially the section line of Sections 14 and 13-T78N-R3W and 18, 17, 16, 15, and 14-T78N-R2W (south junction Iowa 38) at a point near the SE Corner Section 11-T78N-R2W; thence in a northerly direction following substantially the section line of Sections 12 and 1-T78N-R2W to the south corporation line of the City of Wilton, connecting with an unnamed street.

Wilton:

Beginning on the south corporation line connecting with an unnamed street; thence northerly to the north corporation line connecting with an unnamed street (Muscatine-Cedar County line).

TITLE: US 6, Muscatine County, Iowa

DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND:

Due to a review of our Primary Road System records, US 6 in Muscatine County should be deleted and the new description added should be officially included into the Primary System.

US 6 begins on the Muscatine-Johnson County line near the NW Corner of Muscatine County and travels southeasterly and northeasterly via West Liberty and Wilton to the Muscatine-Cedar County line approximately 3 miles west of Durant, Iowa.

PROPOSAL/ACTION RECOMMENDATION:

Locate US 6 and its extensions in Muscatine County as follows:

Beginning on the Muscatine-Johnson County line at a point approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile south of the NW Corner Section 6-T78-R4W, Muscatine County (NE Corner Section 1-T78-R5W, Johnson County); thence in a southeasterly, easterly, and southeasterly direction through Sections 6, 5, and 4-T78-R4W to a point approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile east of the SW Corner of Section 4-T78-R4W; thence east following substantially the section line of Sections 9, 10, and 11-T78N-R4W;

thence easterly and southeasterly through Section 12-T78N-R4W to the north corporation line of the City of West Liberty, connecting with an unnamed street.

West Liberty:

Beginning on the north corporation line, connecting with an unnamed street; thence southerly & easterly to the east corporation line, connecting with an unnamed street.

Beginning again on the east corporation line of the City of West Liberty, connecting with an unnamed street; thence in an easterly and southeasterly direction through Sections 12-T78N-R4W and 7-T78N-R3W to a point approximately 1000 feet east of the SW Corner Section 7-T78N-R3W; thence in an easterly direction following substantially the section line of Sections 18, 17, 16, and 15-T78N-R3W to a point approximately 700 feet east of the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section 15-T78N-R3W; thence in a northeasterly and southeasterly direction through the south part of Section 10-T78-R3W, crossing the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railway overpass at a point approximately 500 feet west of the NE Corner Section 15-T78-R3W, and in a southeasterly and northeasterly direction through the north part of Sections 15 and 14-T78-R3W to a point approximately 700 feet east of the NW Corner Section 14-T78-R3W; thence east following substantially the section line of Sections 14 and 13-T78N-R3W and 18, 17, 16, 15, and 14-T78N-R2W (south junction Iowa 38) at a point near the SE Corner Section 11-T78N-R2W; thence in a northerly direction following substantially the section line of Sections 12 and 1-T78N-R2W (north junction Iowa 38) at a point approximately 630 feet north of the W $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section 1-T78N-R2W; thence easterly through Section 1-T78N-R2W to the west corporation line of the City of Wilton, connecting with an unnamed street.

Wilton:

Beginning on the west corporation line connecting with an unnamed street; thence easterly to the east corporation line, connecting with an unnamed street.

Beginning again on the east corporation line of the City of Wilton, connecting with an unnamed street; thence northeasterly along the north side of the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railway and substantially parallel thereto, through Sections 6, 5, and 4-T78-R1W, to the Muscatine-Cedar County line at a point approximately 400 feet east of the N ¼ Corner Section 4-T78-R1W, Muscatine County (St Corner Section 33-T79-R1W, Cedar County).

Beginning again on the Muscatine-Scott County line at a point approximately 250 feet east of the N ¼ Corner of Section 6-T78N-R1E, Muscatine County (S ¼ Corner of Section 31-T79N-R1E, Scott County); thence easterly along the Muscatine-Scott County line following substantially the section line of Sections 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1-T78N-R1E to the Muscatine-Scott County line at a point near the NE Corner of Section 1-T78N-R1E, Muscatine County (SE Corner of Section 36-T79N-R1E, Scott County).

NOW, THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Iowa Department of Transportation approve the location of US 6 in Muscatine County, Iowa.

Beginning on the Muscatine-Johnson County line at a point approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile south of the NW Corner Section 6-T78N-R4W, Muscatine County (NE Corner Section 1-T78N-R5W, Johnson County) thence in a southeasterly, easterly and southeasterly direction through Sections 6, 5, and 4-T78N-R4W to a point approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile east of the SW Corner of Section 4-T78N-R4W, thence east following substantially the section line to a point approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile east of the NW Corner Section 12-T78N-R4W, thence in a southeasterly direction to the north corporation line of the Town of West Liberty, connecting with an unnamed street.

Beginning again on the east corporation line of the Town of West Liberty, connecting with Third Street, thence in a southeasterly direction to a point approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile east of the SW Corner Section 7-T78N-R3W, thence east following substantially the section line to a point approximately 700 feet east of the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section 15-T78N-R3W, thence in a northeasterly and southeasterly direction through the south part of Section 10-T78N-R3W, crossing the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railway overpass at a point approximately 500 feet west of the NE Corner Section 15-T78N-R3W, and in a southeasterly and northeasterly direction through the north part of Sections 15 and 14-T78N-R3W to a point approximately 700 feet east of the NW Corner Section 14-T78N-R3W, thence east following substantially the section line to a point approximately 1200 feet west of the SE Corner Section 11-T78N-R2W, thence curving in a northeasterly direction to a point approximately 1200 feet north of the SE Corner Section 11-T78N-R2W, thence north following substantially the section line to a point approximately 600 feet north of the W $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section

1-T78N-R2W, thence east to the west corporation line of the Town of Wilton Junction, connecting with Fifth Street.

Beginning again on the east corporation line of the Town of Wilton Junction, connecting with Fifth Street, thence in a northeasterly direction along the north side of the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railway and substantially parallel thereto, through Sections 6, 5, and 4-T78N-R1W, to the Muscatine-Cedar County line at a point approximately 400 feet east of the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section 4-T78N-R1W, Muscatine County (S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section 33-T79N-R1W, Cedar County).

Beginning again on the Muscatine-Scott County line at a point approximately 400 feet east of the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section 6-T78N-R1E, Muscatine County (A point approximately 200 feet east of the S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section 31-T79N-R1E, Scott County) thence east along the Muscatine-Scott County line to a point near the NE Corner Section 1-T78N-R1E, Muscatine County (a point approximately 200 feet east of the SE Corner Section 36-T79N-R1E, Scott County).
