TITLE: US 6, Madison County

DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND:

Due to the relocation of US 6 and to maintain continuity in the US Route Numbering System the description of US 6 in Madison County should be officially included in the primary road system.

US 6 begins at the Madison-Adair County line approximately six miles west of the City of Earlham and proceeds easterly and northeasterly to the Madison-Dallas County line approximately four miles northwest of the City of Earlham.

PROPOSAL/ACTION RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended the commission approve including the attached description of US 6 in Madison County in the primary road system.

Locate US 6 in Madison County as follows:

Beginning on the Madison-Adair County line at a point 1428 feet north of the SW Corner Section 6-T77N-R29W, Madison County (SE Corner Section 1-T77N-R30W, Adair County); thence easterly through Section 6-T77N-R29W to a point 1667 feet north of the SW Corner Section 5-T77N-R29W; thence curving in a northeasterly direction and continuing northeasterly through Section 5-T77N-R29W to the Madison-Dallas County line at a point approximately 1285 feet west of the NE Corner Section 5-T77N-R29W, Madison County (SE Corner Section 32-T78N-R29W, Dallas County).
